Leprosy – (Lev 13:45-46)

Why is there illness?

Broken World Lord's Discipline (1 Cor 11:27-32, Prov 3:12 and Heb 12:6) Demonic Activity God's Glory (John 9:2-3)

<u>Illness is not evil</u>, though it resulted from evil...

...but under God's Sovereignty, it can also be a means of bringing glory to God

The good news is about a KINGDOM!

Slide Jesus doesn't just cast out Satan's demons, He overthrows Satan's kingdom!

Kingdom conferred upon the apostles (Matt 16:19, Luke 9:1, Luke 10:9)

"Lord, if You are willing, You can make me clean."

POSITION: He IS LORD, MASTER, KING -

POWER: He **CAN** make us clean, whole, righteous, healthy, fruitful...

PREROGATIVE: He CHOOSES... It is entirely up to Him!

Mark 1:43 Then He [Jesus] <u>sternly</u> warned him and <u>sent him away at once</u>, 44 telling him, "See that you <u>say nothing to anyone</u>; but go and show yourself to the priest, and offer what Moses prescribed for your cleansing, as a testimony to them." 45 <u>Yet he went out and began to proclaim it widely</u> and to spread the news, with the result that Jesus could no longer enter a town openly.

Disobedience always hinders God's work...

Let's circle back to THREE items:

ONE: "Lord, if You are willing, You can make me clean."

Position, Power and Prerogative

God has not changed:

His "position" has not been relegated,

His power has not been reduced, and

His prerogative has not been removed.

He CAN still do what HE chooses to do.
